

Repeat Infringer Policy

Limestone & Bracken Cablevision complies with the Online Copyright Infringement Liability Limitation Act of 1998 (“Act”). As required by the Act, we have adopted a policy to terminate services to account holders or subscribers who repeatedly infringe upon copyrights. In the event that we receive a determination that any subscriber or account holder has infringed another’s copyright through the use of our system or network, that subscriber shall be contact by our office. Service of any subscriber incurring three determinations within a thirty-day period shall be suspended until the infringing material is removed. Further determinations will require proof of removal of the material and/or removal of viruses/programs involved with the issue. We reserve the right to terminate service after receiving notice of any further copyright infringement by that subscriber or account holder.

Limestone & Bracken Cablevision accommodates and does not interfere with standard technical measures to identify and protect copyrighted works, subject to the limitations of the Act.
